Aetna-to-Humana Switch Effective January 1, 2026

Please disregard the recent automatic letter you may have received from Aetna regarding Fulton County's Medicare group coverage.

The letter may have caused confusion, but it does not accurately reflect the County's plans.

For accurate information, please refer to the official statement from the Pension Office below.

■ Important Update for Retirees: Humana to replace Aetna Coverage

Fulton County's retiree health coverage with **Aetna Basic and Aetna Enhanced Medicare Advantage** plans will end on **December 31, 2025**.

Starting January 1, 2026, all retirees currently enrolled in Aetna Basic or Aetna Medicare will be automatically transitioned to Humana's Basic or Enhanced Medicare Advantage Plan. Your pharmacy coverage will also move to Humana on this date.

Welcome packets from Humana will go out mid-November, and ID cards will be received before the first of the year.

- **☑** No action is required unless you made changes during open enrollment.
- ✓ Plan designs under Humana are the same as your current Aetna coverage, so the transition should be smooth.
