## **Notice to Retirees: New Anthem Pharmacy Program – No Action Required**

Dear Anthem Medicare Plan Retiree,

You may have recently received **Anthem's 2026 Blue Medicare PDP Rx** prescription drug card and letter in the mail. We want to assure you that **no action is required on your part** unless otherwise noted below.

### **What's Changing?**

Fulton County Government is updating its pharmacy program for retirees enrolled in one of our Anthem Medicare plans. This change aligns our plan with **Medicare Part D** to help reduce your prescription drug costs.

This information was also communicated in your **Retiree Benefits Guide** and during **Open Enrollment Zoom sessions**.

### **What You Need to Know:**

- This is **not** a separate Medicare Part D plan through CMS. It is part of your **Fulton County Anthem medical plan**.
- You are **automatically enrolled**—there's nothing you need to sign or return.
- Your new plan includes:
  - Coverage for commonly prescribed and additional medications
  - Access to a **nationwide network of pharmacies**
  - Continued **home delivery options**
- **CarelonRx** remains the pharmacy benefit manager, so your current retail pharmacy should still be in-network.

### **What Should You Do?**

- If you received **Anthem's 2026 Blue Medicare PDP Rx** ID card, simply place it in your wallet and **share the updated information with your pharmacy**. The new coverage is effective **January 1, 2026**.
- If you received a request for a physical mailing address (often due to having a P.O. Box on file), please provide that address to ensure uninterrupted service.
- If you have questions or need help, call Anthem's Rx First Impressions Welcome team and provide this group specific code GA002GRX. 1-866-646-2436 (TTY: 711) Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 9 p.m. ET, except holidays.

### **Important:**

**Please do not complete any forms unless you are choosing to opt out of the new Rx program.**

By opting out, you will **not have pharmacy coverage** under the Fulton County plan and will be responsible for securing your own prescription drug coverage through **Medicare.gov** or another source.
